 IN CAPTIONED MATTER. BACKGROUND IS AS FOLLOWS:

 WILLIAM DALE JONES, WHO WAS SHOT BY SPECIAL AGENT (SA) ROBERT
 G. WRIGHT ON MAY 21, 1993, DURING AN ATTEMPT TO ARREST JONES
 BY AGENTS AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES. JONES WAS THE SUBJECT OF
 TAMPA DIVISION UFAP CASE 88A-TP-21667 TITLED, "WILLIAM DALE

WEAPON; POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY CONVICTED FELON; BURGLARY;

DURING THE DAYS FOLLOWING THE SHOOTING, FITZSIMMONS AND
JONES WERE INTERVIEWED BY VARIOUS LOCAL TELEVISION STATIONS.
DURING ONE OF THE INTERVIEWS, FITZSIMMONS MADE THE STATEMENTS,
"THEY MURDERED MY SON, AND IT'S NOT OVER. YOU'RE GONNA HAVE
TO PUT A BULLET IN MY HEAD FOR IT TO BE OVER." DURING ANOTHER
INTERVIEW, JONES STATED, "THE CRIMES HE WAS SUPPOSED TO HAVE
DONE, EVEN IF THEY WERE TRUE, DIDN'T WARRANT A COLD BLOODED,
HUNT DOWN, SHOOT OUT MURDER. FIRST DEGREE MURDER. THEY HAD
CHANCES TO SUBDUE HIM, AND THEY CHOOSE NOT TO." "...LET HIM
TRY TO FLEE, THEN THEY SHOT HIM COLD BLOOD."

ON JULY 7, 1993, AN AGENT IN THE JEFFERSON CITY RA LEFT THE RA AND WALKED TO THE BASEMENT GARAGE TOWARD HIS BUREAU VEHICLE. HE OBSERVED AN OLDER MODEL, FOUR DOOR FORD, OFF-WHITE OR CREAM COLORED, WITH A TAN OR LIGHT BROWN VINYL TOP, MAKE A LEFT HAND TURN FROM MONROE STREET AND ENTER THE GARAGE. THIS VEHICLE PULLED PAST THE BUREAU VEHICLE AND STOPPED IN THE AISLE. THE AGENT BEGAN BACKING OUT OF THE PARKING SPACE AND OBSERVED A WHITE FEMALE WALKING AROUND THE BACK OF THE FORD VEHICLE, AND THEN TOWARD THE FRONT OF THE VEHICLE. AS HE CONTINUED TO BACK OUT, THE FEMALE APPEARED TO BE TAKING PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE VEHICLES PARKED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE GARAGE. AGENT RECOGNIZED THIS INDIVIDUAL AS [REDACTED] b7C
[REDACTED] b7C WAS ASKED, "CAN I HELP YOU?" AND SHE REPLIED, "NO. I'M JUST TAKING PICTURES." SHE THEN TOOK A PICTURE OF THE VEHICLES PARKED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE GARAGE, NEAR THE GARAGE EXIT. SHE ENTERED HER VEHICLE, WHICH WAS BLOCKING THE AISLE, AND DROVE OUT OF THE GARAGE AND MADE A

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VISIT ONE OF THE LAW FIRMS IN THE BUILDING. SA WRIGHT STAYED IN THE BUILDING LOBBY FOR APPROXIMATELY FIVE MINUTES TO SEE IF THE INDIVIDUALS ENTERED THE BUILDING, WHICH THEY DID NOT.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT [REDACTED] GREW UP IN JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, AND HAD NUMEROUS FRIENDS AND RELATIVES, MANY OF WHOM APPEAR TO HAVE LITTLE RESPECT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS. b7c

KANSAS CITY DIVISION HAS INITIATED CAPTIONED INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE IF, IN FACT, THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PERCEIVED THREAT IS REAL AND TO DETERMINE THE EXTENT OF THAT THREAT. FBIHQ WILL BE KEPT ADVISED OF DEVELOPMENTS IN THIS INVESTIGATION. AS KANSAS CITY DIVISION HAS NO IDENTIFIERS ON CAPTIONED SUBJECTS AT THIS TIME, BUREAU INDICES SEARCHES WILL BE REQUESTED AT A LATER DATE.

SAC, KANSAS CITY BELIEVES THAT REGARDLESS OF THE OUTCOME OF THE AFO INVESTIGATION, THERE WILL CONTINUE TO BE A HOSTILE ENVIRONMENT TOWARDS SA WRIGHT IN THIS SMALL COMMUNITY.

Reference is made to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request regarding Kansas City file 89B-KC-72064.

Enclosed are copies of documents from our file. Excisions have been made from these pages in order to protect information exempt from disclosure pursuant to the following subsection of Title 5, United States Code, Sections 552 and 552a: (b) (6), (b) (7) (C) and (b) (7) (D). See Form OPCA-16a enclosed, for an explanation of these exemptions.

Pursuant to your request, twelve pages were reviewed and six pages are being released.

Notations have been made in the margins of the enclosed pages indicating specific exemptions applied to excised portions of the material.

In addition, you requested a copy of Kansas City teletype to FBI Director dated July 14, 1993, requesting the transfer of Special Agent Wright to a top fifteen office. That document was not located in file 89B-KC-72064.

If you desire, you may submit an appeal from any denial contained herein. Appeals should be directed in writing to the Co-Director, Office of Information and Privacy, U. S. Department of Justice, Flag Building, Suite 570, Washington, D. C. 20530, within thirty days from receipt of this letter. The envelope and

the letter should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Appeal" or "Information Appeal". Please cite the name of the office to which your original request was directed.
