

ON JULY 7, 1993, AN AGENT IN THE JEFFERSON CITY RA LEFT THE RA AND WALKED TO THE BASEMENT GARAGE TOWARD HIS BUREAU VEHICLE. HE OBSERVED AN OLDER MODEL, FOUR DOOR FORD, OFF-WHITE OR CREAM COLORED, WITH A TAN OR LIGHT BROWN VINYL TOP, MAKE A LEFT HAND TURN FROM MONROE STREET AND ENTER THE GARAGE.
