On Monday, June 7, 1993, the mother of WILLIAM DALE JONES, telephonically contacted Special Agent (SA) ROBERT G. WRIGHT, JR. at the Jefferson City Resident Agency regarding the May 21st shooting of WILLIAM DALE JONES.

advised that she had no intentions of pursuing any civil action against anyone as a result of her son's death.

advised she would like to obtain the items (fishing pole, .22 rifle, trailer jacks, etc.) that were in the subject's Ford pickup truck.

advised that she wanted to inform SA WRIGHT about the subject's life, so that SA WRIGHT did not know only the bad things about the subject. The subject's mother was only 17 when she gave birth to the subject, his father had just turned 18. The subject's father did not take any interest in the subject during the subject's lifetime.

wanted specific details concerning the shooting on May 21, 1993, in which her son (subject) was fatally shot. She was informed that the front right tire of the subject's vehicle was flattened and the subject was going to be apprehended while he was changing the tire. SA WRIGHT further explained why the subject was not apprehended prior to entering the pickup truck, and the events leading up to the subject being transported to the hospital.

advised that in the recent past she had made the following statement to the subject, "You have been nothing but trouble all your life." added that something in the subject changed, "you could see it in his eyes", after this statement was made to him. Stated, "I just hoped that someday I could get close to him and make up for saying what I said."

wanted by law enforcement authorities. After admitting that she was aware of the subject's fugitive status, she stated, "There now, you can come and arrest me for harboring a fugitive."

also advised that the subject had mentioned the May 7th car chase in Orlando, Florida, to her "a couple of times."

advised that in the past couple of months, the subject had indicated that he was scared of law enforcement authorities, and felt that they were going to harm him. When asked by the agent why her son just did not surrender himself to the Jefferson City Police Department while in the area, commented that she felt a lot of police officers are bad and cannot be trusted, therefore the subject did not surrender. Advised that she and the subject talked about him possibly surrendering while he was home.

On at least three occasions, stated, "You killed my son." The agent's reply to was that her son could have prevented the entire incident had he surrendered rather than attempting to flee, using violent means, and trying to strike and physically harm or kill another human being.
