[REDACTED] has recently [REDACTED], and is temporarily residing [REDACTED], Jefferson City, Missouri [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] has resided at that address for approximately one month. [REDACTED] has worked at [REDACTED], Jefferson City, Missouri, for approximately two years, as a [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] first met [REDACTED] approximately one month ago. [REDACTED] met him while living with another friend who lived near [REDACTED] residence. Often, the people who lived in the area would congregate at a parking lot near [REDACTED], drink beer, and talk. [REDACTED] met [REDACTED] on one of these occasions, and after several meetings, became good friends with him. After a short time, [REDACTED] and still resides [REDACTED] along with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (Last Name Unknown) (LNU) run a home repair business called RAY'S HOME IMPROVEMENT. This business is run from [REDACTED] which is located in a warehouse on Highway 179.

[REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] was aware that [REDACTED] and most of the other people who reside in the area [REDACTED] were acquainted with WILLIAM JONES. The shooting of JONES at the JUNGLE BAR in May, 1993, often was the topic of conversation at the above described beer drinking sessions. [REDACTED] was also aware that [REDACTED] was a personal friend of [REDACTED], who was the mother of JONES. [REDACTED] partner in his home repair business, whose name was [REDACTED] (LNU) was living with [REDACTED] (LNU), who was [REDACTED] daughter and JONES' sister.

Shortly after [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] confided [REDACTED] that several weeks previous, [REDACTED] had asked him to kill the person who shot her son, WILLIAM JONES. Although [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] the dollar amount that [REDACTED] offered him, [REDACTED] did not recall the exact amount, but believed it to be ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] approached him because she was aware he had shot a policeman previously in St. Louis, and had a reputation of not being afraid of the police.

[REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he declined [REDACTED] proposition. He has also since reassured her that [REDACTED] was just emotionally stressed over the recent death of her son, and was not serious about having anyone killed.

[REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] (LNU) and [REDACTED] (LNU) the previous evening at [REDACTED] which was located on the east side of Jefferson City.
