[REDACTED] advised he was convicted in 1986 or 1987 of
"driving while intoxicated", and was placed on probation as a
result of this. He is no longer on probation, and has had no
other criminal convictions.

He was a friend of WILLIAM JONES, as well as other
members of his family, including his brother, [REDACTED] his
sister, [REDACTED], and his mother, [REDACTED]

He has also done some carpentry work for
[REDACTED] at her residence located near the [REDACTED]
of Jefferson City. He is aware that JONES' family is very upset
over JONES' shooting death several months ago, and has talked to
both [REDACTED] about the facts of the shooting on several
occasions.

When questioned by the interviewing agents as to
whether [REDACTED] ever approached him with a request to
kill the person responsible for JONES' death, he initially denied
ever being approached. However, when questioned further, [REDACTED]
admitted that approximately one month ago, [REDACTED] approached
him. He had been visiting with [REDACTED] and other family
members at her residence. At one point in the visit, while they

were outside of the residence, [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to the side outside of hearing range of the others, and asked him would be willing to kill the person who had murdered her son, "BILLY". [REDACTED] advised it was evident [REDACTED] was emotionally upset over the death. He did not recall if [REDACTED] offered him money for the killing. Because of [REDACTED] emotional state at the time, he did not take her request serious, and has not discussed it with her since that time. He was unaware if she had approached anyone else about this matter, but felt that she had calmed down since that time, and no longer was serious about the killing.

[REDACTED] advised that at the time of the above conversation, [REDACTED] mentioned that she felt that law enforcement had her telephone wiretapped. She did not offer any explanation why she felt this. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] He was unaware why she felt this way, but believed that the whole family, since the shooting, was paranoid about law enforcement watching them.

[REDACTED] advised if he learned that [REDACTED] was actually trying to have the person who shot JONES killed, he would not notify law enforcement, but would try to talk [REDACTED] out of it.
