after being requested to come to the FBI office for interview,
which she did, and being advised of the official identities of
the interviewing agents, and that the interview concerned an
"Assault on a Federal Officer" matter, advised as follows:

She is [REDACTED] of WILLIAM JONES, who was killed by
law enforcement officers trying to apprehend him on May 21, 1993,
in Jefferson City, Missouri. Since the shooting she has been
extremely upset with the way that all of the law enforcement
officers and agencies have handled the incident. She did not
believe that law enforcement was justified in categorizing her
son as "dangerous", and felt that many of the charges against him
were "made up".

[REDACTED] denied ever approaching anyone to kill the
law enforcement officer who shot JONES. She advised that she was
the kind of person who would do such a thing herself, if that is
what she felt should be done. However, she felt too many people
were responsible, and not just the person who did the actual
shooting. She advised that she would hurt the people
responsible, but not in a physical way. She advised that she
would expose the wrongs law enforcement had committed against her
son, and her family.

[REDACTED] admitted that she had entered the basement
area of the HAWTHORN BUILDING in Jefferson City on July 7, 1993,
and attempted to photograph the area. She advised that the
purpose of this was to prove to her husband, [REDACTED] that a parking
lot existed there. In a previous discussion, he told her such a
lot didn't exist, and she wanted to prove to him it did. She
advised that unknowingly, she did not have any film in the camera
when she tried to take the pictures. [REDACTED] denied ever
driving through the above described parking lot on any other
occasion.
