Reference is made to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts request dated May 3, 2001 for information pertaining to yourself.

Excisions have been made from these pages in order to protect information exempt from disclosure pursuant to the following subsections of Title 5, United States Code, Section 552 and 552a: (b)(1), (k)(1), (b)(6), and (b)(7)(c). (See Form 4-694a enclosed, for an explanation of these exemptions.)

These records concerning you also contain personal information about other individuals, e.g. an associate, without whose written consent release to you is precluded by the Privacy Act. Additionally, this information, which is being withheld from you pursuant to subsection (b)(6) or (b)(7)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, was not used by the FBI as a basis for making any determination about you.

Pursuant to your request, 39 pages were reviewed and 39 pages are being released.

Notations have been made in the margins of the enclosed pages indicating specific exemptions applied to excised portions of the material.

If you desire, you may appeal any denials contained herein.
