(G, (P) was concerned for several reasons:



(G)(P) advised SA Abdel-Hafiz of his uneasy feeling with the situation and asked if he should resign. SA Abdel-Hafiz advised (G)(P) that he (Abdel-Hafiz) is not aware of any investigation regarding those individuals nor the companies he mentioned. SA Abdel-Hafiz advised (G)(P) to remain with his employment as long as he desires and there should not be any reason to be alarmed. SA Abdel-Hafiz also advised (G)(P) to continue carrying out his duties as usual.
