## Re: Interviews of Special Agents Robert Wright & John B. Vincent

On Sunday evening, March 31, 2002, Special Agent Robert Wright faxed to the Office of Public & Congressional Affairs New York Times reporter Judith Miller's questions, and Agent Wright's answers to those questions. Special Agent Vincent's answers to the questions were included in the fax. In addition, Agent Wright faxed approximately forty (40) additional pages of public source information in support of answers to question number 28.

We understand from our co-counsel, David P. Schippers, Esq., that the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Northern District of Illinois declined to respond to your specific request in review of these questions and answers, because the U.S. Attorney's Office determined they did not contain "6e" or other confidential material.

Unless we receive written communication to the contrary from you by 3:00 PM Eastern Standard Time on Thursday, April 4, 2002, this will constitute a further confirmation of your consent that Special Agent Robert Wright and Special Agent John B. Vincent speak with Ms. Miller of the New York Times.
